## JIMMYS

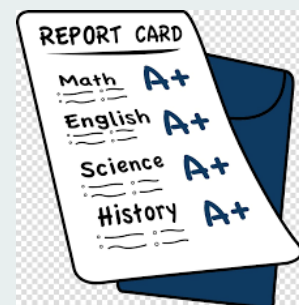
