GRANT AWARDS

We have successfully bid for and won the following grants:

1. Local School Nature Grants Scheme

We are delighted to announce that we have been awarded a Local School Nature Grant. Thanks to players of the People's Postcode Lottery, our pupils will be benefiting from:

- a. Play Out Kit and Learn and Play Out Books.
- b. A Woodland Activity Kit which provides ideas and activities for playing with children in a woodland setting, together with a leaf print set and some animal footprints on wooden discs.
- c. Ground Cover Kit - Class set of Foam mats, Roll mats, Kneeler mats, Waterproof picnic blanket rug and tarpaulins
- d. Wildlife Watching Kit - A wildlife camera with night vision, a range of wildlife products such as a hedgehog home, nest box, bee home and window feeder which will be used to enhance our outdoor learning in the Eco Zone .

The project is run by Learning through Landscapes and funded by People's Postcode Lottery.

2. Ernest Trust Outdoor Essentials Grant - (Transport and Travel)

We received a grant of £500.00 towards Transport and Travel for Outdoor Learning.

3. Casdon Toys 'Helping out in the Home Corner' initiative

We have won a huge bundle of toys worth over £150 to enhance our role play areas. The packs are full of fun activity sheets, certificates and stickers along with child-sized home corner favourites. These include Henry and Hetty vacuum cleaners, cleaning trolleys, a mini Morphy Richards microwave and Kitchen Set plus lots more!
