The school games value for last week was self-belief.

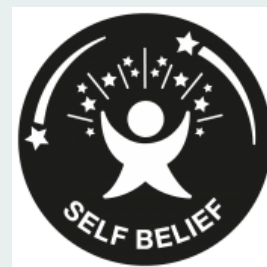
Well done to all the children for showing self-belief in their PE lessons. These children in particular showed great self-belief and received a certificate for their efforts.
