COVID-19 ENHANCED PRECAUTIONS

Until we can assess the level of infection in school following the holiday, we are still implementing some COVID restrictions in school.

If you have any positive COVID cases within your household, all children must be taken for a PCR test and they should only return to school once a negative test result has been received.

If there is a positive case within your child's class, we request that you arrange for your child to have a PCR test. Your child does not need to isolate unless they are demonstrating symptoms or receive a positive result.

As children are displaying a variety of symptoms, we request that if your child is unwell you arrange for them to have a PCR test. We understand that there are the usual seasonal bugs around, however, it is proving difficult to separate the common cold from COVID-19 in a lot of cases.

Adults **MUST** wear a mask on school premises.
