## INTERNET SAFETY—IS TIKTOK SAFE FOR CHILDREN?

A recent report by Ofcom highlighted that over half of 3-17-year-olds are using TikTok. TikTok is a video-sharing platform where you can watch and create videos, and livestream. The app has an age-rating of 13+.

TikTok can be a creative outlet for young people as it allows them to learn about video editing and discover new interests. However, it can be easy for children and young people to come across inappropriate content on the app.

The platform also has communication features that allow users to privately message each other which could put your child at risk of being contacted by someone they don't know.

Keep your child safe on TikTok using the safety settings.
