Online Safety	DIGITAL LITERACY HEALTH, WELLBEING & LIFESTYLE I can explain how using technology can be a distraction from other things, in both a positive and negative way. I can identify times or situations when someone may need to limit the amount of time they use technology e.g. I can suggest strategies to help with limiting this time.
