All the equipment that the children need will be provided so please do not bring in pencil cases etc so that we can avoid property being lost or damaged.

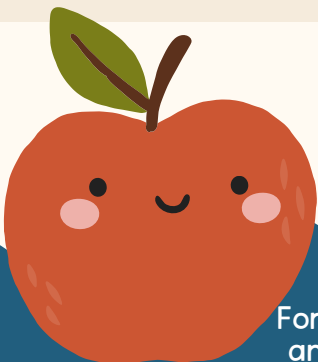
Please bring in a named water bottle to keep in class. Children who would like a snack at break may bring in a piece of fruit.
