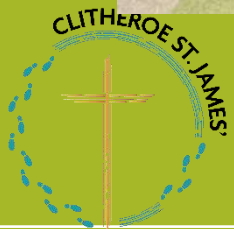

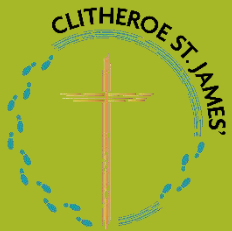

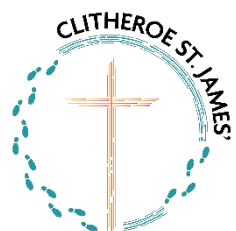

- Be respectful

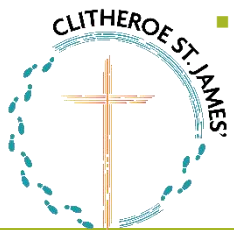
- Be safe

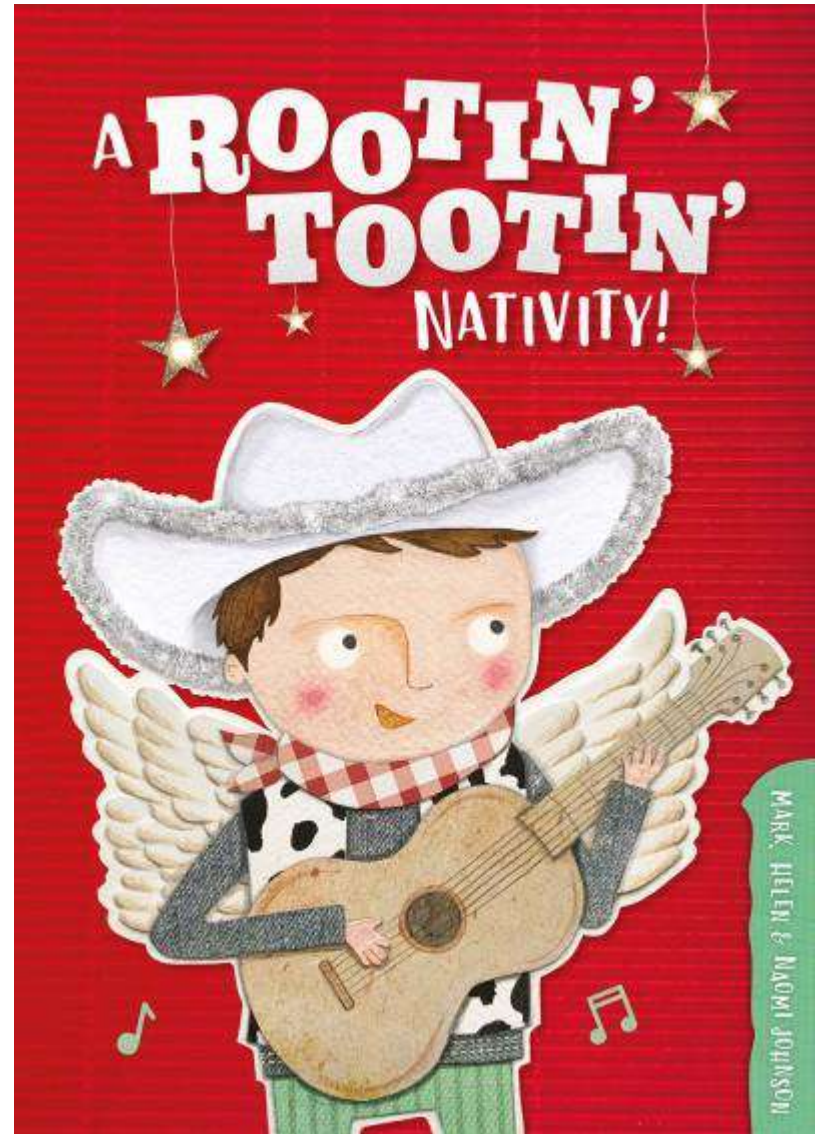
